



Request: There is a railroad crossing in the heart of the City of Livingston and the sound of a train horn can be an annoyance to residents and businesses. The City would like to request that the Federal Railroad Administration designate this crossing as a “Quiet Zone”.

Description: Quiet Zones are railroad line segments where rail engineers do not have to sound their train horns as they approach the crossing.

Necessity: Given the close proximity of the railroad tracks to many homes and downtown businesses we would like the Federal Railroad Administration to use their established rules and methodology for establishing, maintaining, and enforcing a quiet zone.

We understand that there might be a need to implement additional safety measures to keep pedestrians, vehicles and the like safe. These additional improvements could be different Quadrant gate arms, pedestrian gates, channelization, safety signage, audible and visual alerts.
